DIRECTIONS TO THE EAGLETON INSTITUTE

The Eagleton Institute of Politics is located at **191 Ryders Lane** in New Brunswick, NJ, 08901. The main building, also known as **Woodlawn**, is a converted house with a large front lawn (you may also see a sign for the Carriage House, which is behind Woodlawn). See the photo below.




To get to Eagleton from the **University Inn**, simple cross Ryders Lane at the crosswalk by the bus stop and walk straight up the path to Eagleton.



To get to Eagleton from the **Heldrich Hotel**, simply follow George Street in the opposite direction to the train station. After passing a pedestrian bridge, take the first right on the roundabout and then turn right into the driveway for the Eagleton Institute. Walking will take 20-25 minutes, but brings you through a slightly dodgy couple of blocks. It is a short car ride, however, and we are looking into arranging transportation for those staying at this hotel.



To get to Eagleton from the **New Brunswick train station**, you will find taxis on the side of the Trenton-bound tracks (the ones coming from New York Penn Station). Walking will take around 30 minutes. If walking, go to the intersection of Albany Street/George Street and turn right on George Street (you will see Chipotle and Starbucks on that block). You will pass the **Heldrich Hotel** along the way; after which follow the directions above. If taking a taxi to either the University Inn or the Eagleton Institute, direct the driver to go in the **direction of the Heldrich** and then continue up George Street (the street is oneway in the opposite direction by the station, so the driver has to circle around to get back on George St).



To get to Eagleton from **Route 1**, take the Ryders Lane exit in the direction of New Brunswick. The driveway will be on your left, where the road bends sharply to the right. If coming from the **New Jersey Turnpike/I-95**, take Exit 9 onto Route 18 and either follow your GPS or take the Route 1 exit in the direction of Princeton/Trenton and then the Ryders Lane exit to New Brunswick.



Free **parking** is available in Lot 82 (your best bet, next to the University Inn and just across the street from Eagleton) and Lot 74A (not labeled as such on this map, but the lot marked as P at the top-left of this map). There is also a parking lot at Eagleton, but technically you need a visitors' tag. You may want to try your luck, though. You can access this parking lot by going up the drive and past the house (the lot is at the bottom left of this map).
